# Miss Messenger Bag

This casual cross-body bag is the perfect partner for the girl on the go. Spacious enough for travel documents and reading matter, it keeps your hands free as you do a bit of shopping in the airport. I have fused the fleece to the lining fabric this time, to reduce bulk and make the zip insertion on the outer bag neater.

# Finished size

With flap open, 12½ x 15in (31.75 x 38cm) With flap folded over, 12½ x 10½in (31.75 x 26.75cm), not including strap

# What you need

36 x 18in (91.5 x 45.75cm) outer fabric 40 x 9in (101.5 x 23cm) faux leather

26 x 18in (66 x 45.75cm) lining fabric 26 x 18in (66 x 45.75cm) fusible fleece

Two 1in (2.5cm) D-rings

Two 1in (2.5cm) swivel snap hooks

10in (25.5cm) nylon zip

6in (15.25cm) of ¼in (5mm) wide ribbon to trim the zip pull

Magnetic clasp

Fabric glue pen

#### Cut

Two pieces of outer fabric measuring 13in (33cm) square

Two pieces of faux leather measuring 13 x 5in (33 x 13cm)

For the lining, two pieces of lining fabric and two pieces of fusible fleece measuring 13 x 17in (33 x 45.25cm)

For the pocket, two pieces of outer fabric measuring 10 x 8in (25.5 x 20.5cm)

For the strap, one piece of faux leather measuring 4 x 40in (10 x 101.5cm)

For the handles, two pieces of outer fabric measuring 4 x 11in (10 x 28cm)

For the tabs, two pieces of outer fabric measuring 4 x 3in (10 x 7.5cm)



Sew a piece of faux leather to the bottom of each of the outer fabric pieces. Press the seam open and topstitch along each side of the seam. You will need to put a cloth over the seam when pressing so as not to melt the coating on the faux leather.

2 Take one of the pocket pieces and on the back, draw a box measuring 8 x ½in (20.5 x 1cm), centrally, 1½in (4cm) from the top. Draw a line straight through the centre of the box, and create a 'Y' shape at each end.



# Finished size

14½ x 12½ x 5½in (37 x 31.75 x 14cm), not including handles

## What you need

54 x 18in (137 x 45.75cm) outer fabric 54 x 18in (137 x 45.75cm) lining fabric 45 x 18in (112 x 45.75cm) fusible fleece 15 x 5in (38 x 13cm) mesh bag base Four bag feet

90in (228.5cm) piping: mine was shopbought; to make your own see page 16 50in (127cm) of 1in (2.5cm) wide bias binding

20in (51cm) nylon zip 2½in (6.5cm) and 4in (10cm) circle templates Strong wet fabric glue

### Cut

Two pieces of outer fabric and fusible fleece measuring 14 x 111/2in (35.5 x 29.25cm) for the front and back panels

Two pieces of lining measuring 14 x 121/2in (35.5 x 31.75cm) for the front and back panels

One piece each of outer fabric, lining and fusible fleece measuring 14 x 4in (35.5 x 10cm) for the base

Two pieces of outer fabric, lining and fusible fleece measuring 11½ x 6in (29.25 x 15.25cm) for the ends: measure 1in (2.5cm) from each bottom corner, and cut from here to the top corners to taper

Two pieces each of outer fabric, lining and fusible fleece measuring 4 x 11in (10 x 28cm) for the zip panel

Two pieces of outer fabric measuring 1½ x 3in (4 x 7.5cm) for the zip tabs

One outer and one lining fabric piece, each measuring 6 x 7in (15.25 x 18cm) for the patch pocket

Two outer and two lining strips of fabric for the handles, each measuring 2½ x 20in (6.5 x 51cm)

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Tuse the fleece to the back of the outer front and back panels. Curve the bottom two corners of the outer and lining front and back pieces using your 4in (10cm) circle template. Sew a piece of piping, raw edges together, around the sides and bottom of the front and back pieces, starting and stopping 1½in (4cm) from the top. Turn the ends of the piping to the outside of the edge to make neat.

2 Sew a strip of piping across the top of the outer pocket piece.



# Finished size

8½ x 6½in (21.5 x 16.5cm)

# What you need

18 x 18in (46 x 46cm) outer fabric 13 x 18in (33 x 46cm) lining fabric 9in (23cm) square faux leather 13 x 18in (33 x 46cm) fusible fleece 6in (15.25cm) zip

Magnetic clasp

One swivel snap hook on a 1in (2.5cm) ring 6in (15.25cm) of ¼in (5mm) wide ribbon to decorate the zip pull

8in (20.5cm) of ¼in (5mm) wide ribbon for the bow and one button (optional)

#### Cut

Two pieces of outer fabric measuring 9 x 9in (23 x 23cm)

Two pieces of faux leather measuring 9 x 4½in (23 x 11cm)

Two pieces of lining fabric measuring 9 x 13in (23 x 33cm)

Two pieces of fusible fleece measuring 9 x 13in (23 x 33cm)

For the pocket, two pieces of outer fabric measuring 7 x 6in (18 x 15.25cm)

For the wristlet, one strip of outer fabric measuring 3 x 14in (7.5 x 35.5cm)

For the tab, one piece of outer fabric measuring 3 x 3in (7.5 x 7.5cm)

1 Sew the faux-leather strips to the bottom of the two larger outer pieces. Press the seam open and top-stitch either side. Place a cloth over the faux leather to avoid melting it with your iron.

2 Draw a box measuring 5 x ½in (13 x 1cm) on the wrong side of one of the pocket pieces, centrally, 1in (2.5cm) from the top, with a line across the centre forming a 'Y' shape at each end. Pin this piece right sides together with one outer bag piece 6in (15.25cm) from the top and sew around the box. Cut along the centre line and into the corners of the sewn box.





Tip

You might want to add a second magnetic clasp to the fold-over flap, or make a ribbon tie to keep the flap closed.

# Finished size

14½ x 12½ x 5½in (37 x 31.75 x 14cm), not including handles

# What you need

54 x 18in (137 x 45.75cm) outer fabric 54 x 18in (137 x 45.75cm) lining fabric 45 x 18in (112 x 45.75cm) fusible fleece 15 x 5in (38 x 13cm) mesh bag base

Four bag feet

90in (228.5cm) piping: mine was shopbought; to make your own see page 16 50in (127cm) of 1in (2.5cm) wide bias binding

20in (51cm) nylon zip 21/2in (6.5cm) and 4in (10cm) circle templates Strong wet fabric glue

#### Cut

Two pieces of outer fabric and fusible fleece measuring 14 x 111/2in (35.5 x 29.25cm) for the front and back panels

Two pieces of lining measuring 14 x 121/2in (35.5 x 31.75cm) for the front and back panels

One piece each of outer fabric, lining and fusible fleece measuring 14 x 4in (35.5 x 10cm) for the base

Two pieces of outer fabric, lining and fusible fleece measuring 111/2 x 8in (29.25 x 20.5cm) for the ends: measure 1in (2.5cm) from each bottom corner, and cut from here to the top corners

Two pieces each of outer fabric, lining and fusible fleece measuring 4 x 11in (10 x 28cm) for the zip panel

Two pieces of outer fabric measuring 1½ x 3in (4 x 7.5cm) for the zip tabs

One outer and one lining fabric piece, each measuring 6 x 7in (15.25 x 18cm) for the patch pocket

Two outer and two lining strips of fabric for the handles, each measuring 2½ x 20in (6.5 x 51cm)



 $\mathsf{I}$  Fuse the fleece to the back of the outer front and back panels. Curve the bottom two corners of the outer and lining front and back pieces using your 4in (10cm) circle template. Sew a piece of piping, raw edges together, around the sides and bottom of the front and back pieces, starting and stopping 1½in (4cm) from the top. Turn the ends of the piping to the outside of the edge to make neat.

Sew a strip of piping across the top of the outer pocket piece.
