BLUEBELL

SIZE

Approximately 15cm (6in) long, including stem

MATERIALS

- 5g (½oz) of 4-ply (fingering) yarn in lilac (A) and a small amount in green (B)
- A small amount of toy stuffing
- 40cm (16in) length of lightweight wire
- Liquid glue

TOOLS

- Pliers

FLOWERS (MAKE 5)

With yarn A, cast on 8 sts.

Row 1 (WS): p to end.

Row 2: (kfb) to end (16 sts).

Rows 3–9: starting with a p row, work 7 rows in st st.

Row 10: k3, turn. Work on this set of 3 sts only. Leave remaining sts on LH needle.

Row 11: p2tog, p1 (2 sts).

Row 12: skpo and fasten off.

*Do not turn. Move on to the next set of 3 sts and repeat rows 10–12. Repeat * four more times to create five petals in total. 1 st left.

Fasten off remaining st.
